GoPro looks to outside developers

"Your GoPro is about to get a lot more powerful," said Lexy Savvides in CNET.com. The action-camera maker announced a new developers program last week to support third-party companies building apps and accessories that connect with GoPro products. Already, more than 100 companies have joined the program, including BMW, which has an app called M Laptimer that allows racing enthusiasts to use their GoPro to automatically record car speed and location and replay video of the drive. Fisher-Price is developing GoPro-compatible mounts that attach to children's jumperoos and walkers so parents can capture milestones from their little one's perspective. "GoPro had a shaky start to 2016"; after weaker-than-expected sales in 2015, the company laid off 7 percent of its workforce in January.
